NIGHT OF DESTRUCTION 2023

TYPES OF VEHICLES:

- <u>Enduro and Trailer Race</u>: Any TRUCK, CAR, SUV, VAN (NO all wheel drives in Enduro Class) (No 1 tons, nothing bigger than a ³/₄ ton unless I approve it) In the event that you have a dually, the inside tire must be off or flat. **Derby cars that survive the day show can also be used for all classes**. **small** and **BIG** vehicles will run separate enduro heats **BUT** will run the feature together.
- <u>Figure 8</u>: MIDSIZE CARS, MINI VANS, and S-10 size or similar trucks. NO FULL SIZE TRUCKS, FULL SIZE CARS, DERBY CARS IN FIGURE 8. No all wheel drive.
- <u>Trailer Race:</u> 4-wheel drive and 2-wheel drive will be in the same class

REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION

- Anyone under the age of 18 needs a parent release and notary stamp. **Need to have notary filled out before show**. EVERYONE MUST HAVE A FORM OF ID. Check our website for pre-registration papers if you're under 18 or stop in at West End Salvage to pick up a copy.
- Registration opens approximately 30-60 minutes after the demo derby is completed.

OFFICIALS DECISIONS

• WHAT THEY SAY IS FINAL! If it's not in the rules, it's not legal. Any car considered dangerous or unfair will be rejected.

DRIVER ENTRY FEES

- \$60 for one derby vehicle and driver pit pass CASH ONLY
- \$80 for two derby vehicles and driver pit pass CASH ONLY

PIT PASS

- \$20 CASH ONLY
- No one under 18 is allowed in the pits unless you're a driver.

SAFETY/PPE: You must wear a helmet, jeans, and long sleeve shirt. **Seat belt MUST work. Window net required**. (Round stock welded to door, seat belts, racecar nets, etc.) **Optional-** Five-point safety harness and roll bar loop.

<u>GLASS/TRASH</u>: Windows, headlights, mirrors, and taillights must be removed. Absolutely no glass or trash in any vehicle or trailer! Clean your fricken vehicles out!!! (Only glass exception is windshields, they can stay in your vehicle) If you bring a camper, clean out all trash and glass. You will not be allowed to participate and or be disqualified if we find any after the race.

WINDSHIELD: Can be removed, if removed you must have a working face shield on helmet! Must have 2-3 chains or wires, running from roof to firewall for safety if windshield is removed.

<u>CAR NUMBER</u>: Cars can be decorated in any manner within the limits of good taste. No obscenity. Use a number of your choice. Car number must be on driver door, passenger door, and on a <u>MANDATORY 12"X12" minimum roof flap</u>. Make sure the number is a contrasting color to the door. (EX: Black door, white number!)

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NIGHT OF DESTRUCTION RULES

HOODS: Must be fastened with 2 chains, 2 wires, or 2 threaded rods. We do not want your hood to come open during the event. Cut at least one hole in hood for fire extinguishing.

<u>GAS TANKS AND BATTERIES:</u> Both can stay in their factory positions. If you choose to move your gas tank look at the derby rules for specs.

DOORS: MAX: 3 chains, doubled up #9 wire per door or 3 plates 2"x6" max. MINIMUM is 1 chain, loop of #9 wire OR plate 2"x6" IF ANY DOOR COMES OPEN YOU WILL BE **DISQUALIFEID FOR SAFETY REASONS**. Drivers door may be welded all the way around. I suggest that you reinforce your driver door for your safety (driver's door only) My suggestions would be **ONE** of the following options: weld door shut, lay flat steel across, angle iron across door. Window net required- See "Safety/PPE" section NOTICE: Absolutely no driver's door hits in any race, heat, or event!

BUMPERS: They need to be chained or wired on with chains or #9 wire. We do not want your bumpers to be on the track! If you choose to put on an aftermarket bumper see the "Bumper" section in the mini rod class. Do not show up with a homemade contraption and expect to run.

SAFETY BARS: If dash is removed, **1st** bar may be mounted horizontally above steering column. At least 1 chain has to go around steering column for safety or 2 can go around bar and then be attached to the body/frame for safety.

* 2nd bar may be mounted horizontally from post to post up to behind driver's seat. This bar can be mounted 12 inches behind the factory seat setting or MAX 12 inches behind the driver's doorpost. Must be mounted 3" up or down from center of seat. Bar used square or round 3" to 6" in diameter. Plates used up to 8"x8" may be used to mount seat bar on the inside post or on the outside of the doors. Mandatory: pipe used behind seat must have at least 1 safety chain or 2 chains max around it and secured through the floor for safety. The chain can go around the frame.

* 3rd and 4th Bars. Door bars can be connected from dash bar to seat bar. May be bolted or welded. No bars smaller than 3" in diameter or larger than 4" or less than 1/4" in thickness or channel 3" in width or lager than 4". Door bars cannot extend past the bars they connect with. You will torch or load it up. Rollover bars can be welded to rear seat bar and fastened with 3" bolts max in roof. Max 3" pipe or channel.

TRAILER RACE VEHICLES: NO brush guards allowed. You can use 1 tire (tire size not to exceed a 22.5 semi tire) without rims and fasten them with a chain or cable to the front of your vehicle to resemble a push guard.

TYPES OF TRAILERS for Trailer Race Vehicles: Boat, snowmobile, camper, etc. NO implement or wagons! Trailers must have something on or in them (recliners, couch, boat, etc.) Clean out all TRASH in campers please! **Trailers deemed unsafe or not realistic will not be allowed to run. Refs discretion. I recommend you call before bringing something ridiculous.** We will strictly enforce trailers and it's cargo.

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ATTACHMENT OF TRAILERS: Standard coupling (ball and hitch). Pin hitch allowed ³/₄" pin max. **NO welding your pin on.** Normal safety chains and one log chain (log chain—one loop around bumper and one loop around tongue of trailer). Official decisions will be final upon inspection.
